LOCAL ELECTIONS

CHECKING YOU ARE ON THE CENSUS VOTING LIST FROM APRIL 10TH TO APRIL 17TH

To check that you are on the census voting list for the local elections that will be held on Sunday 28th May, please go to the Padron Department on the ground floor of Nerja Town Hall from **Monday April 10th to Monday April 17th**. **Opening hours: Monday to Friday from 8 am to 2 pm.** Present your passport, identity card or TIE residencia.

If there is any error in your details or if you don't figure on the census list, you can make any modifications during these dates at the Town Hall Padron Department.

If you have a digital signature you can also check at the Malaga Census Office INE, *Oficina del Censo Electoral* at sede.ine.gob.es or phone 900 343 232.

British will only be able to vote if they have returned and signed the letter received by post last December.

POSTAL VOTING UP TO 18TH MAY

If you will not be here to vote personally on May 28th, you can also make a postal voting **up to 18th May**. You have to go to the post office and register for the local elections giving an address where you want to receive by post the electoral documents. Before 24th May, the Census Office will send you all the ballot papers for you to choose which political party you want. Then you have to send the chosen ballot back in the self addressed envelope.

If you have a digital signature “certificado digital”, you can contact the Post Office www.correos.es and apply for the postal voting.
